School Bus

<u>Rules</u>

To ensure safe, efficient transportation service, students should:

- Arrive at the bus stop 5 minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive.
- Wait in locations clear of traffic and away from the bus stop.
- Face the front at all times!!!!
- Go directly to your assigned seat.
- Remain seated, keeping aisles and exits clear.
- No Standing while the bus is in motion.
- No Profane language or being disrespectful.
- No Eating or Drinking
- No Spraying (Hairspray, hand sanitizer or perfume).
- No Picture or Video taking.
- No Fighting or Name calling
- No Horseplay or moving seats
- No Throwing objects/paper
- No Screaming, use your inside voice.
- No Arms or yelling out of window
- No Talking at railroad crossings!!!!
- Treat others the way you want to be treated!!
- All school buses are equipped with video-camera equipment to assist in monitoring students behavior.

Safety Assembly (KS version)

Having a naughty student is a good idea, it keeps the students attention while they are learning bus safety.

Pick 1 student or more to help, have them be a student on the bus

More chairs available. You are setting up the appearance that you are all on a school bus

Front seat-bust driver
Second seat - students
Third seat, bus driver acting as student

Covering the topics
Be ready at least 5 minutes early/here comes the bus app
Procedure during and after an accident
Crossing in front of the bus/ neve behind the bus
Why overhead lights come on
Using good bus behavior

Make it a skit type of thing?

a driver can be standing and appear to be waiting for the bus, students (driver) can be talking about how they know that being on time to the bus is important. Staying in the designated bus stop area, especially in the dark, will help keep the bus on schedule, as well as keep them safe.

Another driver can be acting as if they are approaching the students at a stop, as if they are the bus driver coming to pick them up.

Be sure to remember covering lights on and quiet at RailRoad Tracks

Student walks onto bus and immediately begins doing things that are not appropriate on the bus Such as

Music on their phone,

Taking pictures

Switching seats

opening windows to far

Hanging out windows

Laying back in seat

Hanging out in aisle

Not guiet when lights come on

Spraying perfume on bus

Yelling at bus driver

Poking an annoying student in front of them,

Eating snacks

Pulling their mask

Getting on the floor

Encouraging questions, and always share the correct way, and why

What to do in case of an emergency

Ready 5 minutes early: keeping the bus on schedule/ and not hurrying, which can make you fall, and being at our stop when it's dark or a substitute helps a lot for the driver to be able to see you

Here Comes the Bus App: share with them that this is and give the information for it

Crossing in front of the bus: Always watch the driver

Wait for signal (universal crossing sign)

Walk not run

When crossing in front of highland, be sure to

- Use the crosswalk look both ways before crossing
- · Watch for any approaching vehicles. Busses, cars, trucks
- DO NOT cross unless you know the driver sees you

Overhead lights: quiet when the lights are on at RR Tracks, as well as any other time. Lights off means driver needs your attention

Good Bus Behavior: do your best to cover all on the sheet of bus rules
